Bachelor of Pharmacy (B. Pharm) – 60 Seats

B. Pharm (Lateral Entry) – 06 Seats

B. Pharm is a four-year regular course (Semester System) aimed to train students focusing on Herbal and Synthetic Drug Discovery, Organic and Medicinal Chemistry, Human Anatomy and Physiology, Formulation Development, Quality Analysis, action of drugs on animals and humans, Pharmaceutical Management, Jurisprudence, Pharmaceutical Marketing, Computer Science, Mathematics and Biostatistics. Regular instructions and practical sessions followed by internal assessment and University examinations are conducted. The course includes one month internship practical training and industrial visit. Departments at the UG level include Pharmaceutics, Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacognosy and Phytochemistry, Pharmaceutical Analysis & Pharmacology and Toxicology.

Diploma in Pharmacy (D. Pharm) – 60 Seats

Diploma in Pharmacy is a two-year programme for aspirants who want to foray into Pharmaceutical business and jobs related to Pharmacy. Diploma in Pharmacy can also be pursued in order to understand the basics of the programme and pursue advanced courses in this field. The programme covers basic Pharmacy education including application of chemistry in Pharmaceutical industry, concepts of Biochemistry, Pharmacology and Toxicology. 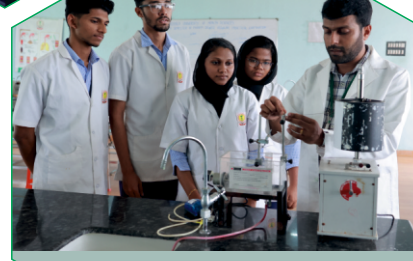

Eligibility Criteria

B. Pharm

Candidates shall have passed 10+2 examination conducted by the respective State/Central Government authorities recognized as equivalent to 10+2 examination by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) with English as one of the subjects and Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Biology as optional subjects, with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics/Biology put together and 50% marks in Mathematics/Biology separately.

B. Pharm (Lateral Entry)

A pass in D. Pharm Course with a minimum of 50% marks in D. Pharm examination from an institution approved by Pharmacy Council of India under Section 12 of the Pharmacy Act (3). Any other qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

D. Pharm

A pass in any of the following Examinations with Physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics: i) Intermediate examination in Science, ii) the first year of three-year degree course in Science, iii) 10+2 examination (academic stream) in Science, iv) pre-degree examination, or v) any other qualifications approved by PCI as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

M. Pharm

A candidate who has passed the B. Pharm degree examination from Kerala University of Health Sciences or an examination equivalent thereto of any other University recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences with not less than a total of 55% marks for B. Pharm degree examination shall be eligible for admission to M. Pharm course. The candidate should have undergone B. Pharm degree in an institution approved by PCI.
